



THE INSTITUTE OF LAW CLERKS OF ONTARIO INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY FELLOWSHIP COURSE

The Institute of Law Clerks of Ontario (“ILCO”), is offering the Intellectual Property Fellowship course (“IPF”). This advanced level course covers the following concepts: copyright (works protected, rights protected, infringement); trade-marks (types, scope of protection, prosecution, registration, oppositions, infringement, licensing); patents (patentable inventions & subject matter, criteria, application process, infringement, maintenance); other forms of intellectual property, plus enforcement, remedies and commercialization.

The IPF course instructor is Catherine Douglas, who has practiced as a registered Trade-mark Agent in Canada since 1998, both in-house and in private practice, with clients from across North America. She is currently a Fellow Member with ILCO and a Fellow and Council Member of the Intellectual Property Institute of Canada (IPIC). As well as having been a Director for the McGill University Continuing Education Trade-marks Course, she has lectured there since 2007. Ms. Douglas has also enjoyed being a guest presenter at the Schulich School of Business, Osgoode Hall, Women in Film & Television and other industry-focused seminars, as well as at ILCO’s own Annual Conference. Ms. Douglas brings a practical perspective to this fascinating area of law and business activity.

The course will run for 14 weeks and will consist of lectures supplemented by written material. Students will be evaluated on the basis of one final examination.
